The Wolfville Farmers' Market had humble beginnings in 1992, with nothing more than a dream and three vendors selling products from the trunks of their cars. The market today has grown to become a thriving and important community venue, facilitating local farmers, chefs and artisans in connecting with the greater community.

The Wolfville Farmers' Market Co-operative is in the process of renovating and developing the west portion of the DeWolfe Building, a pre-1900 apple warehouse as a new and permanent home for the market. A permanent home will enhance the market's ability to better serve its customers, the community, improve food safety and give a needed boost to the local agricultural economy.

What to Expect!

Our new home will provide vendors with sinks for food safety, power for display fridges and vertical shelving for professional displays. This will mean we are able to offer a greater variety and consistency of product on market days. We will add a mid-week market to our traditional Saturday Morning Experience.

We will have sky-lighting above a multi-use area with a stage, a commercial teaching kitchen, public washrooms, office space, accessible entrances, and a seating area. We envision evening cooking classes, and special community events in the market hall and using the space to its full capacity as a community hub. The market will also pay taxes and contribute more to town and county life.

Investment Option

We are considering forming a WFM Investment Cooperative to manage a NS Equity Tax Credit program. Investors would then be able to purchase \$100 shares in our project (to a max of \$1,000) and be eligible to receive the NS Equity Tax Credit of 35% while receiving one vote in the WFM Investment Cooperative. To qualify, the investment would be required to remain with the Cooperative for a period of no less than 5 years.
